

Residents of Harris WCID 92

BEST TRASH is the trash and recycling collection provider Trash collection days are every Wednesday and Saturday. Recycle collection day every Saturday.

Garbage collection: Residents provide their own trash can as long as it is between 30-50 gal in size or may place trash out in trash bags for collection.

Recycle collection: in 18-gallon BEST TRASH provided recycle bin Please have trash and recyclables out to the curb by 7:00 a.m.

<u>TRASH</u>: On each regularly scheduled collection day, Best Trash will collect residential refuse located in resident provided trash can limited to 30-50 gal in size or may place trash out in trash bags for collection. Any trash and cart must be placed at the street by the curb by 7am on the day of collection.

EXCLUDED ITEMS: dirt, sod, mulch, rocks, bricks, tile, concrete, tires, batteries, motor oil, cooking oil, sheetrock, insulation, construction debris, waste generated by a private contractor, or any materials or items deemed hazardous materials. **Please do not dispose of gasoline, motor oil, paints, cooking oil, or any other liquid items in a container that are not visible to Best Trash personnel.** If such items result in spillage that causes a stain, Best Trash is not responsible for the cleanup. Best Trash will leave a tag explaining the reason for any non-collected item(s).

<u>HEAVY TRASH</u>: Offered every collection day. Trees, shrubs, brush trimmings and fencing must be no larger than 4" inches in diameter, no more than 4' feet long, tied in bundles not exceeding 40 pounds. Tied bundles are required to allow quick pick up and size limitations are required to avoid damaging the equipment in the compacting process. Best Trash will collect up to 3 cubic yards (up to 10 bags OR 10 bundles) of yard waste each service day. Items such as appliances, furniture, mattresses will be collected on both service days, the limit is 2 large items per collection day. Carpet (up to 1 room of carpet, cut less than 4 feet wide, tied in bundles not exceeding 40 pounds), will be picked up on both garbage collection days. By Federal Law, refrigerators, freezers, and any other items containing Freon must be drained of Freon and have an accompanying bill to validate such service was performed.

<u>SPECIAL COLLECTION SERVICE:</u> For more than normal amounts of residential refuse, yard trimmings or bulk items, Best Trash does have the ability to provide a special collection service. RECYCLEABLE ITEMS: PAPER (including cardboard), PLASTICS (1-5,7), ALUMINUM and TIN cans and GLASS (all colors)

Best Trash takes great pride in our recycle program. Ensuring the best recycle program for our customers takes time and effort on both sides. Please remove caps, liquids and food products from inside the containers. Please only use the provided recycle bin for recyclable materials. The recycle bin is **NOT** an extra trash container and will **NOT** be emptied as such. If items exceed container capacity, please place them adjacent to the cart well marked as recyclable materials. Cardboard is recyclable, please break down all boxes flat, and place them next to the recycle container for collection.

<u>CART CARE & MAINTENANCE:</u> Best Trash will provide each current residence with ONE 18-gallon recycling bin. Best Trash will replace any recycle container that is defective or otherwise become unusable due to normal wear and tear. Lost or stolen containers can be replaced for a fee by calling Best Trash or emailing customerservice@besttrashtexas.com.

<u>HOLIDAY SCHEDULE:</u> If your regular trash or recycle collection day falls on a holiday (New Years Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, or Christmas Day) the collection will be made on the next regularly scheduled collection day.

WCID 92 Trash Guidelines

Quick Pickup Guide

- Pickup Days Wednesday & Saturday
- Have items out by 7AM
- Items must be placed curbside
- Bulk items picked up on Wednesday & Saturday
- 2 bulk item limit per day
- Resident provides own trash can
- Residents must provide their own trash container any size shape or color is acceptable
- Trash service days are Wednesday & Saturday
- Items must be placed curbside by 7:00AM.
- Trash must be properly contained in either bags or cans, each weighing less than 40 lbs.
- Yard waste will be collected curbside. Yard waste has a limit of 8 bags, bundles or a combination per pickup day.
- All trash and yard waste should be placed in sturdy plastic bags weighing no more than 40 pounds each.
- All branches and tree trimmings should be no more than 3 inches in diameter and no longer than four (4) feet in length. Bundles must be securely tied and weigh less than (40) forty pounds each.
- Bulk items/heavy trash will be picked up curbside on Wednesday & Saturday. There is a limit of two items per household per week. Bulk item must be less than 5 feet in length.
- Holidays observed are: New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day. If the holiday falls on a regularly scheduled service day, there will be no service that day.
 Service will resume on the next <u>scheduled</u> collection day following the holiday.

EXCLUDED ITEMS

- Excluded items: It is illegal to transport any hazardous waste in a trash truck and dispose of it in a landfill. Hazardous waste includes: medical waste, toxic or radioactive waste, any appliance containing Freon, acids, car batteries, dead animals, and chemicals of any kind, car parts, car tires, and construction trash (includes concrete, large quantities of carpeting, fencing, rolls of carpet or any construction type material or debris). Other excluded items include: Large pieces of glass (must be broken down in smaller pieces and placed in a closed box and labeled), metal items, improperly contained animal waste (animal waste must be placed in a sealed bag to be serviced). CFC (Freon) items are no longer acceptable items at the landfills, so we are no longer able to pick up refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners or any other item containing Freon.
- Excluded Liquid Waste Toxic or radioactive waste, Freon, paint, acids, petroleum products or filters are not accepted, cooking oil, or chemicals of any kind.
- Bulk items which are too large for Contractor to put in with the normal weekly pickup may be collected separately upon request. Party requesting service will be billed separately at a negotiated price depending on size, quantity and handling required to remove and dispose of item(s).
